News: Kristi told us that one of her neighbors at Phillips had moved out and that the county had required her to sell her residence to the county. Ellen showed us the post card she had mailed out to the households most directly affected by airport noise and pollution

- 1) We passed a resolution by acclamation to support the WC Metro District's request that the county put two radar activated speed signs on Upper River Road. I will forward a note of support to Andrew Knapp, County Engineer. We agreed that the two dips and a rumble strip are the best way to control speed in the village and that we should ask the county to put them in when they redo the road in 2028.
- 2) Susie Jimenez has circulated a petition that asks if WC residents would like increased RFTA bus service. We discussed what we might do to improve the service and ridership but came to no clear conclusions except that we should experiment with the schedule.
- 3) The Vision 2050 countywide master plan revision. The next meeting with Planning and Zoning is November 18. The county has revised the language in the plan but we questioned whether they had changed any substance.
- 4) I told the group about the preliminary discussion the DPC had with the potential buyers of the racetrack. The consensus was that it was a positive development but that we should get a set of written commitments on lighting, noise, events, etc. during the process for the racetrack going forward.
